





Historic Town Hall

Münster's landmark - the EUROPAISC Peace of Westphalia was proclaimed here in 1648. The portraits of the envoys of the time can be seen in the original preserved Peace Hall.




St. Lamberti Church

The three cages in which the bodies of Anabaptists were displayed as a deterrent in 1536 hang from the tower of the old market church.



Barrier-free side entrance "Salzstraße" / outer door 90 cm, inner doors 83 cm (can be opened on request) and 80 cm / induction loop in rows 1 to 7 in the centre aisle



St. Paulus Cathedral

Its foundation stone was laid in 1225. The astronomical clock is a treasure of European importance.



Rough cobblestones / barrier-free side

entrance at the "clock portal", from the cathedral square to the right of the high, Gothic cross gable / Induction loop in the first 2 rows of seats on the left. Information in easy language is available




City Museum

From the founding of the city to the café of the 1950s -Münster's history is brought to life on two floors, in 33 cabinets and with numerous models.

Prinzipalmarkt

The heart of the old Hanseatic city beats here - under the archways of the imposing gabled houses, a shopping spree becomes a particularly charming experience.



Kerbs lowered at 7 central points (wheelchair signs on the footpath) and a smooth pavement strip for wheelchair access



Castle

Built by the baroque architect J.C. Schlaun as a prince-bishop's residence, today the seat of one of Germany's largest universities, the Westphalian Wilhelms University. The castle park includes the botanical garden, which is over 200 years old.

Around the Aasee


Just a few steps away from the historic city centre, the lake attracts visitors with its refreshing mix of culture, leisure and nature on picturesque paths in the countryside.



City centre buses operated by Stadtwerke Münster

Only low-floor buses run in Münster. There are raised kerbs at many bus stops to make boarding and alighting virtually stepfree. All buses also have mechanical folding ramps that can be folded out if necessary. There is an extra space with impact protection for wheelchairs and walking frames on the bus. In most buses, this is accessible via the second door

Passenger information systems

At central bus stops in the city centre, there are passenger information systems equipped with a voice announcement system. After pressing a button located on the pillars, an announcement is made as to when which line will reach the stop.

Safely over the cobbles

It belongs to Münster like the cathedral and the arcades: the rough cobblestones in the old town. The medieval streets have been preserved here. To ensure that this atmosphere can also be enjoyed from a wheelchair, there are special crossing fords in many places. A wheelchair sign on the pavement indicates that it is possible to cross the road without a jolt. (purple stripe / legend)
